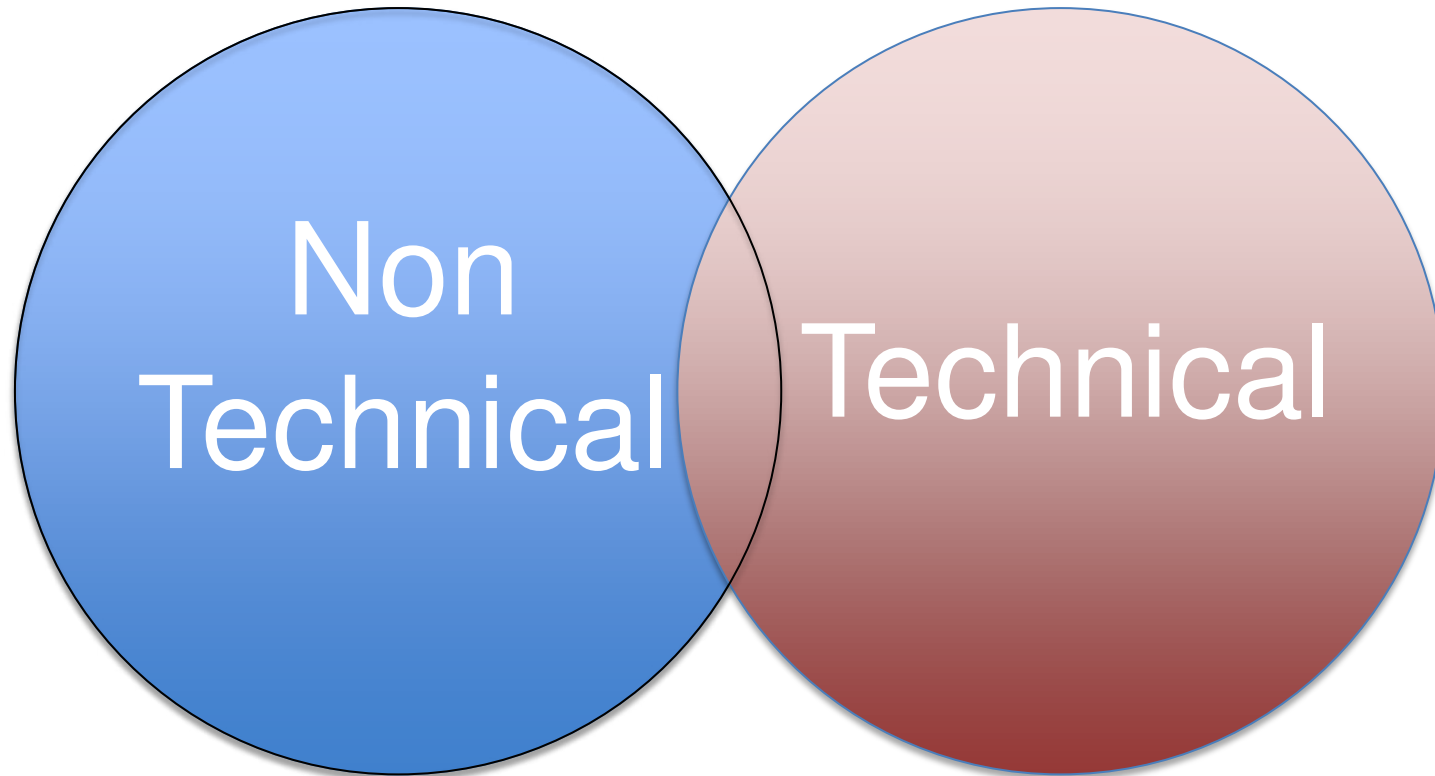
Technically minded

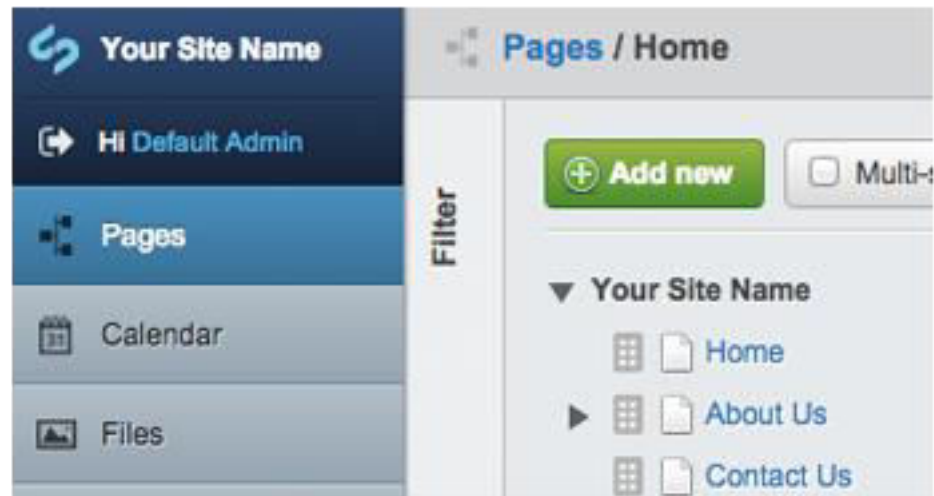

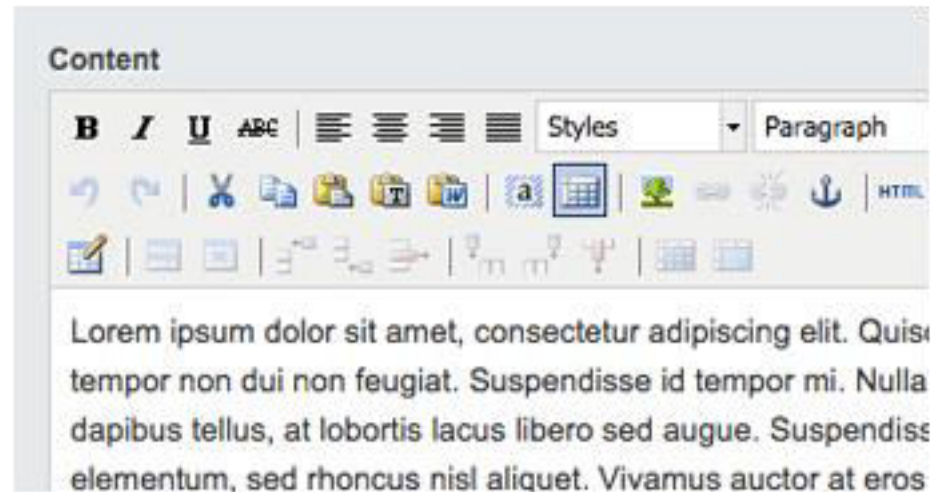

variety of channels

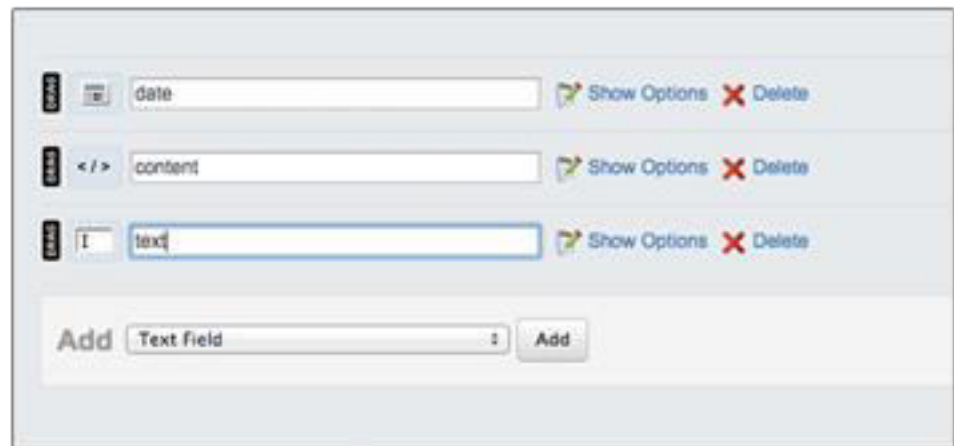


User defined forms

Forms used to be the bane of everyone's lives. Thanks to UDF we can all sleep at night

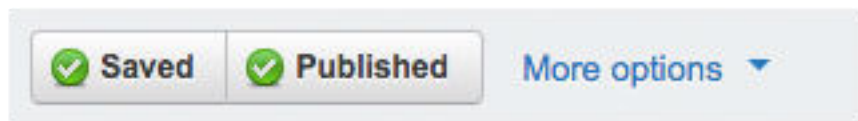

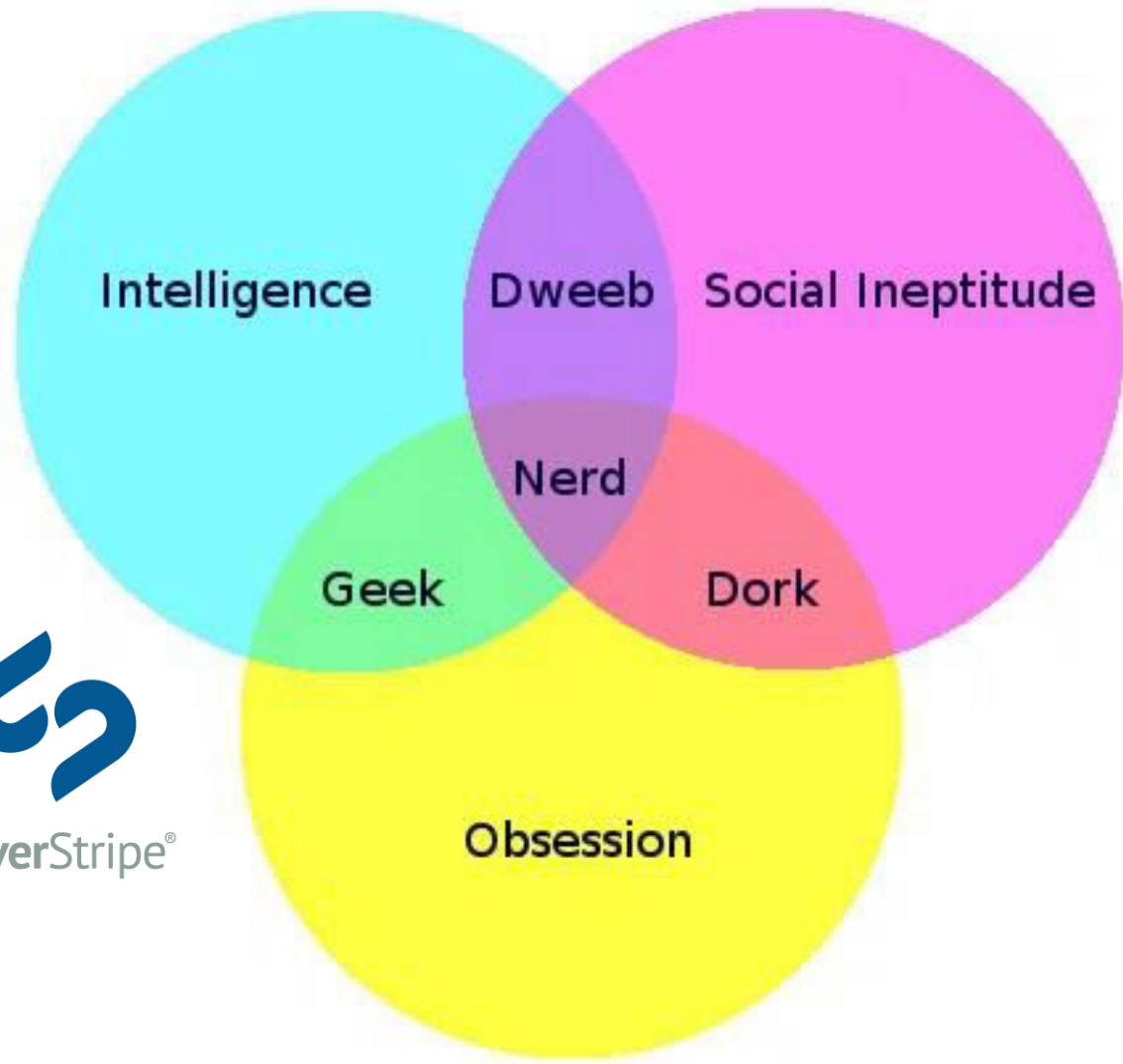
For all the technical people out there:
